

“Banned” Software List:

CCHS’ Acceptable Use Policy states that the major purpose of the installation of educational software and access to the Internet is to enhance learning and that any actions that might harm the computer equipment or software, impair their effective use, or show disregard for the proper procedures set up for network access, will **NOT** be tolerated. As such, it has been determined that none of the applications below serve any educational purpose on campus, and have been found to not only interfere with certain applications needed for class work, but have also been found to cause serious problems, as indicated below. Any service issues encountered that are caused by the installation of these titles on a student’s laptop **will result in the software being removed and/or reimaging the hard drive to take it back to its original state.**

All music/video download software are banned because of issues such as copyright infringement, spyware, high bandwidth use, software conflicts, illegal sharing of files across the network, and/or corruption of the registry. Titles include but are **not limited to:**

Other Banned Software Includes But Is Not Limited To:

ESPN Motion runs consistently, causes your laptop to freeze **Bonzai Buddy** downloads from Web sites you visit –DO NOT allow this to download

Comet Cursor contains spyware, uses resources, causes software conflicts
Web Shots slows boot time/system operation and corrupts registry

Post-It-Notes slows boot time and system operation, causes software conflicts

Gator contains spyware, causes software conflicts

Skype downloads spyware without your knowledge or approval
